Tip to starting a Peyote Stitch Pick up your extra beading needle. Without a thread insert the needle through the beads starting with the last bead (blue bead) then skip the 1st orange bead and insert through the 2nd orange bead. Skip again the 1st white bead and insert through the 2nd white bead.

The Love affirmation bracelet peyote pattern uses a variation of flat peyote stitch called two drop peyote. The basics of two drop peyote stitch are the same as regular peyote stitch, except you pick up two beads per stitch. Like regular peyote stitch, there is an even count version of the stitch and an odd count version of the stitch.

Tips on Beading Using the Peyote Stitch | Interweave

STEP 1 Cut a length of thread (Nymo® or FireLine®) to a comfortable length for you to work with. The longer your thread, the farther you can work before you will have to add a new thread. Thread a beading needle almost doubling your thread but leaving a tail, making it easier to work.
